Karate Kids I ages 4-7
Karate Kids II ages 8-12

Executive Adult Beginners Class

(...for adults that would like to get back into shape, and learn some self-defense, but an easier pace!)

Wednesday Evening

Fall Semester 2009 Class Schedule will be as follows:

Karate Kids I: Wednesdays 5:30-6:15 p.m.
Karate Kids II: Wednesdays 6:30-7:15 p.m.
Executive Adult Beginners: Wednesdays 7:30-8:30 p.m.

Class sizes are small by design, so that your child will get a lot of individual attention.

What do I get for my hard earned money?

- 1 month of lessons for \$50 per month, no Contract. One month of lessons consists of four (4) lessons per month. However I will NOT accept partial payments. Payments will be for one month at a time. It is the responsibility of the parent/child to get to class. If you miss class there is no make-up class. **Check the schedule as posted on the website before coming to class.**
- **1 Uniform:** Students perform better, and feel like they are part of a Karate class, if dressed for the part. Uniforms are black (help's mom keep down dirt) – Price: \$35.

- **1 year of Liability Insurance:** One time fee of \$30 when you start.
- New Beginner's Classes start the week of November 4th, 2009, and will go through the end of February 2010. At that time my new student's are ready to "Graduate" up to their first belt: Gold Belt. There is a "**belt graduation fee**" (some schools call it a **testing fee**) of \$15. This fee covers their new belt and their new certificate. Graduation fees are to be paid up front before students receive their new belt and certification.
- **Then what?** On the traditional yearly schedule, they can continue on through their next Semester (March thru June) and work toward their second belt, if they so desire. If you need to drop-out for a month or two, and come back, the way that I work with you, there is no problem with that. I just do not take partial monthly payments. It is the parents' responsibility to have their child in class.
- I operate on a trimester schedule with each Semester lasting four months. If the student comes to class, AND practices at home, they may be ready to graduate to their next belt/level at the end of the four month period.
- **Are there any other "hidden fees?" NO!** So far this is what we have:

○ Liability Insurance	\$30
○ Uniform:	\$35
○ First month Lessons	\$50
○ Belt Graduation Fee (TBA)	(\$15)
Total:	\$115

(To start class on the week of November 4th, 2009)
- As in any sport, Tae Kwon Do has specific equipment needs as each student progresses through their "belt ranks." When your student reaches their 8 month mark, they will need to purchase their [Sparring Gear Package](#). Our school offers two types of gear packages that will be discussed with you at that time.
- **Can I drop out and come back?** Yes.
- **Can my child get hurt doing this?** Yes. This is NOT some video game. I expect my students to pay attention and do exactly what I tell them to do. If they don't do this, they will be putting other students at risk, and your child's poor behavior will NOT be tolerated. Find another school! On the flip side, I am very experienced at what I am doing, and I will take all reasonable

measure to take very good care of them. They will not spar with a partner until they achieve their second belt, which in our system will be their Orange belt.
